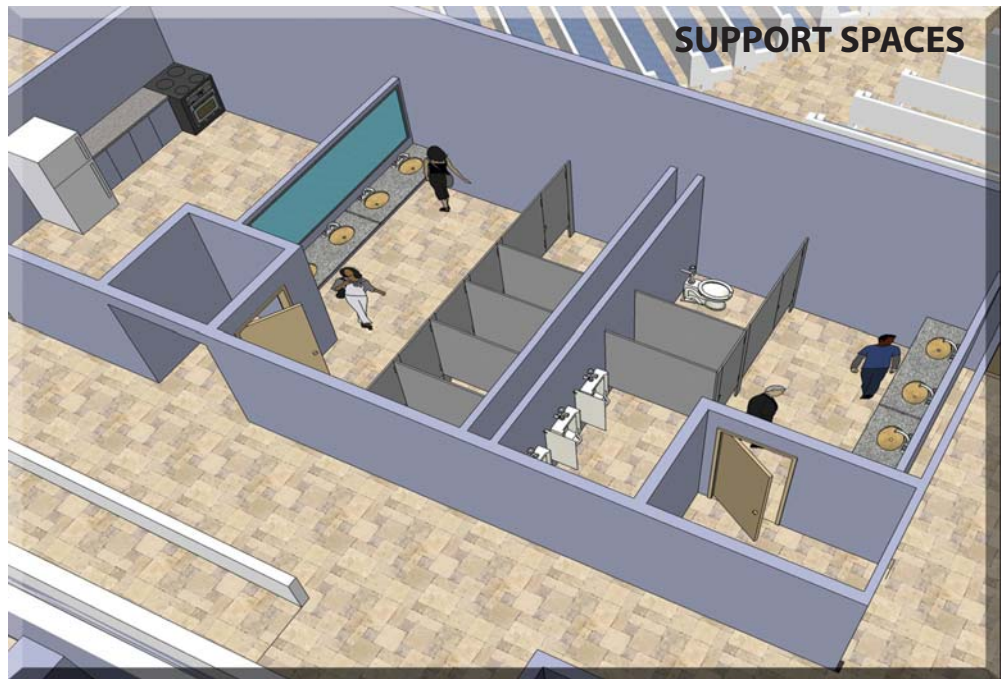

Giving Update

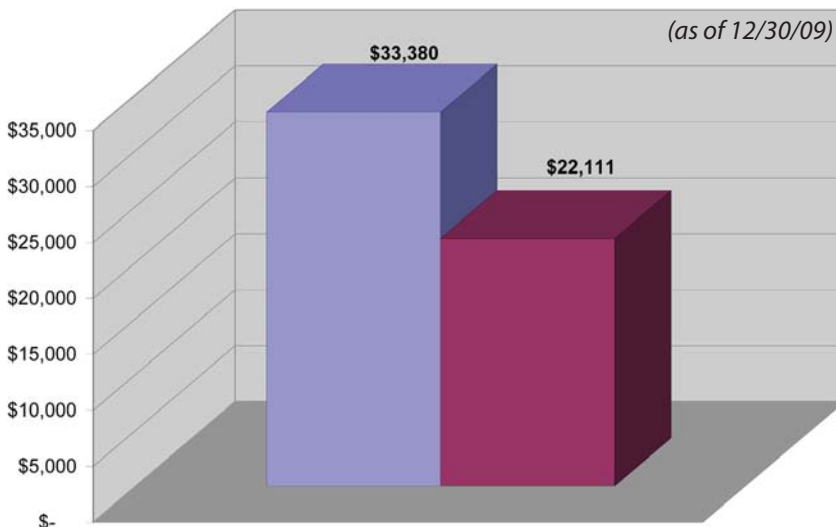
As of 12/30/09, we have received \$22,111 towards the P.I.L.L.A.R. Building Campaign. We are at 66% of our annual goal of \$33,380 pledged.
